Community Art Project: Hokusai in Lisle!

Art Waiver for volunteer artists

The Lisle Library District (LLD) in partnership with Lisle intergovernmental agencies and local businesses seeks volunteers to assist in the creation of public art banners for the Village of Lisle. These banners will become a feature in the downtown and part of a community Hokusai event scheduled for Saturday May 24, 2025. Event activities will coincide with the *Hokusai Floating World Exhibit* coming to the College of DuPage's Cleve Carney Museum of Art in the summer of 2025. *For more information on the exhibit visit theccma.org/Hokusai.*

GOAL

To provide colorful outdoor banners to festoon Lisle's downtown throughout the summer; kicking-off with a Hokusai launch event on Saturday, May 24, 2025 at 10AM. Additional banners will be displayed at the Library's *Gallery 777* during June and July of 2025.

WHO

Members of the public are welcome to participate in the volunteer community art project.

WHAT

Banners are 12" x 24" with greyscale-printed Hokusai imagery on canvas ready for color/paint. Banners are available at the Library via program participation and for public pick-up.

WHERE/WHEN

- Unfinished banners will be available for public pick-up during regular Library hours as of March 24 in the Library lobby while supplies last. The return of completed banners and waivers must be before April 18, 2025 to be considered for the community art project. Individuals are responsible for their own art supplies to complete an unfinished banner.
- **The LLD will host a community art project program on Thursday, April 17, 2025 at 7:30PM at the Library [777 Front Street] in the main meeting rooms. Supplies will be provided by the LLD for this program.**

GUIDELINES

1. Completed banners must be returned to the LLD at 777 Front Street, Lisle, IL 60532 on or before April 18, 2025 between 9:30AM - 9PM Mon-Fri; between 9:30AM - 5PM on Saturdays; and between 1PM - 5PM on Sundays.



2. A parent or legal guardian must sign this waiver for any volunteer artist under the age of 18. School/class participants require a teacher to sign the waiver.
3. Volunteer artists may choose to “color by numbers/within the lines” or color the grey-scale image as creatively as the artist wishes for maximum impact.
4. Completed banners may not contain added political, religious, violent/graphic, or obscene content. All banners will be measured by local community standards for public art/use. The LLD and partnering agencies reserve the right to reject any art banner which it deems inappropriate for public display.
5. Volunteer artists may use a variety of media to ornament/color/decorate the banner. Suggested media include: acrylic/oil paints, markers/inks, crayons, oil pastels, and decoupage. After completed banners are returned to the LLD, the project team will ‘protect’ each banner by applying an outdoor-use spray varnish to each banner.
6. There is no guarantee that weather or other natural elements won’t damage or mar a banner.
7. There is no guarantee that every volunteer-decorated banner will be selected for use in the community art project displays in downtown Lisle or at Gallery 777 at the LLD.
8. Volunteer artists agree that completed/returned art banners are for the benefit of the Lisle Hokusai community art project and are the property of the Village of Lisle. The Village of Lisle owns all rights, titles, and interests in the art banner/s including any intellectual property rights and the ability to photograph and/or video record all banners for use in the community art project.
9. Volunteer artists who pick-up unfinished banners at the LLD shall leave a contact name/number or email with the LLD for communication purposes. The LLD will not use this information for any purpose other than to contact the artist for matters related to the Hokusai community art project.
