Each collection in HeritageQuest needs to be browsed separately and browse options differ by collection. The core or most widely used collections are:



SEARCH CENSUS with original images of every extant federal census in the United States, from 1790 through 1950.

SEARCH BOOKS includes more than 7 million digitized page images from over 28,000 family histories and local histories.

REVOLUTIONARY WAR PENSIONS with files from officers and enlisted men who served in all branches of the military in the Revolutionary War.

FREEDMAN'S BANK includes more than 480,000 names of bank applicants, their dependents, and heirs from 1865-1874.

U.S. SERIAL SET includes memorials, petitions, and private relief actions made to the U.S. Congress back from 1789-1969.
