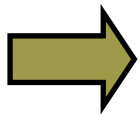
From Your Computer:

Go to: www.lislelibrary.org/LLDdatabases

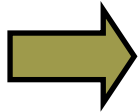
Select "Historical Newspapers."

GETTING STARTED:

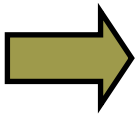


Historical Newspapers include 5 databases: Chicago Tribune (1849-1997), Civil War Era, The Wall Street Journal (1889-2003), The Washington Post (1877-2003), and the Chicago Defender (1909-1975).



For basic searches on all databases enter your search term and click  from the homepage.

To target a particular database, on the toolbar, click the "Databases (5)" tab to view the list and select or deselect the databases you need. Then click "Use selected databases."



You can further refine and narrow your search by clicking the "Advanced Search" tab. In the first row, enter one or more words in the box. Following the box is a drop-down of search fields such as Author, Document title or Publication title. Select from the list or leave the default "Anywhere." Click "Search." You can limit your search even further by Publication date and Document type.
