- A registered voter in the District

Candidates need to know that:

- Two appointments will be made. Each seat is for a two-year term.
- The Board meets once a month for regular meetings. Committee meetings are scheduled
 as necessary and Special meetings may occur as needed. In general, Trustees may attend
 one to two meetings a month, depending on Committee assignments.
